Global Youth Climate Challenges (GYCC)

Founded in 2020, the Global Youth Climate Challenges (GYCC) has played a key role in global youth-led climate action stemming from the Republic of Korea. We have taken a leadership role in the youth sessions of the Partnerships for Green Growth (P4G) and organized youth-driven activities at the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) Conference of the Parties (COP).

A. Youth Global Networking

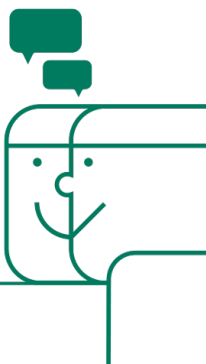

B. Youth Education

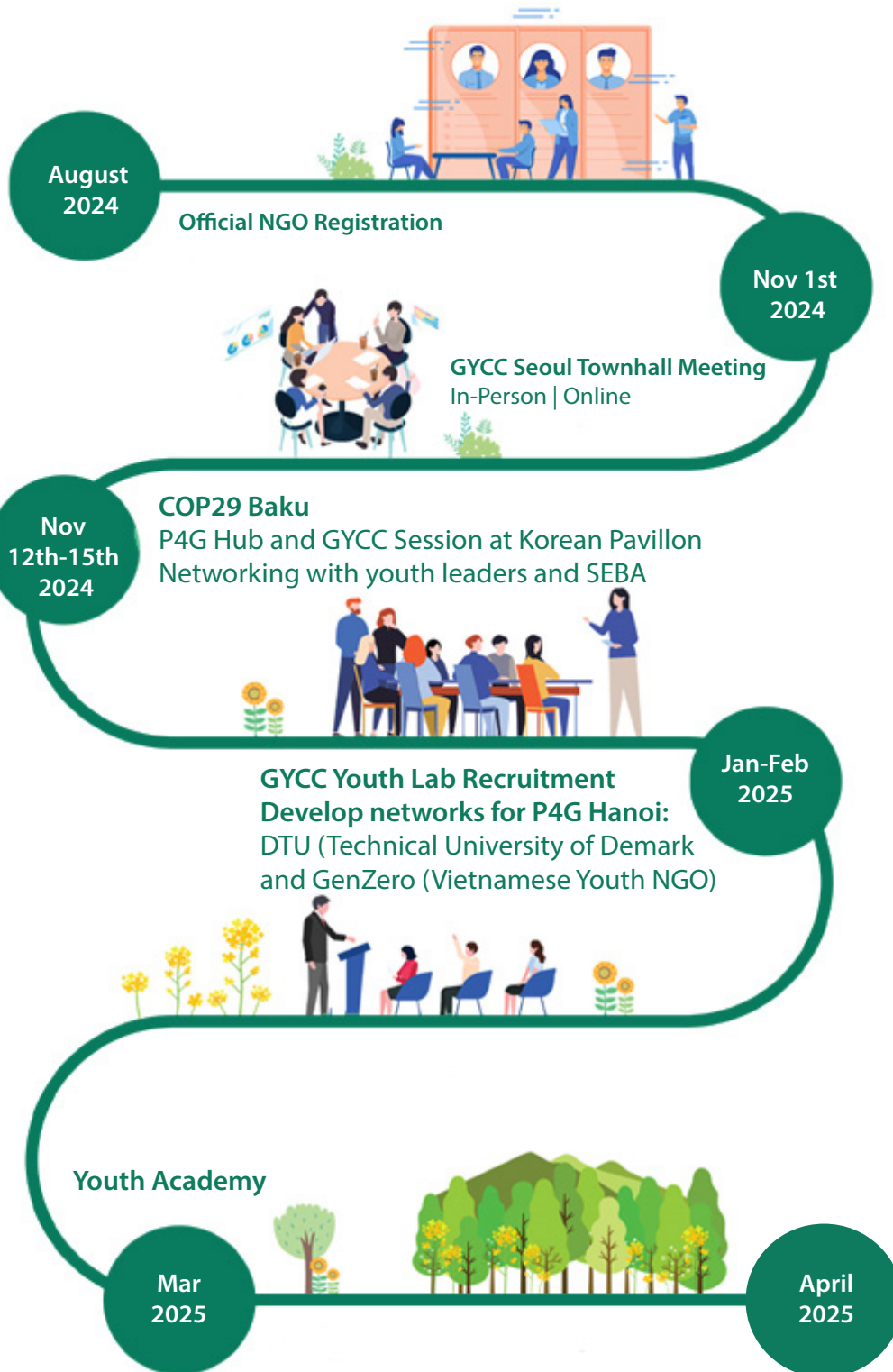

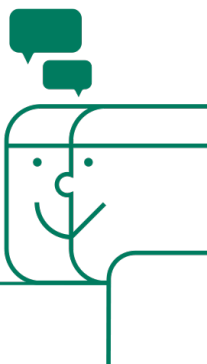
